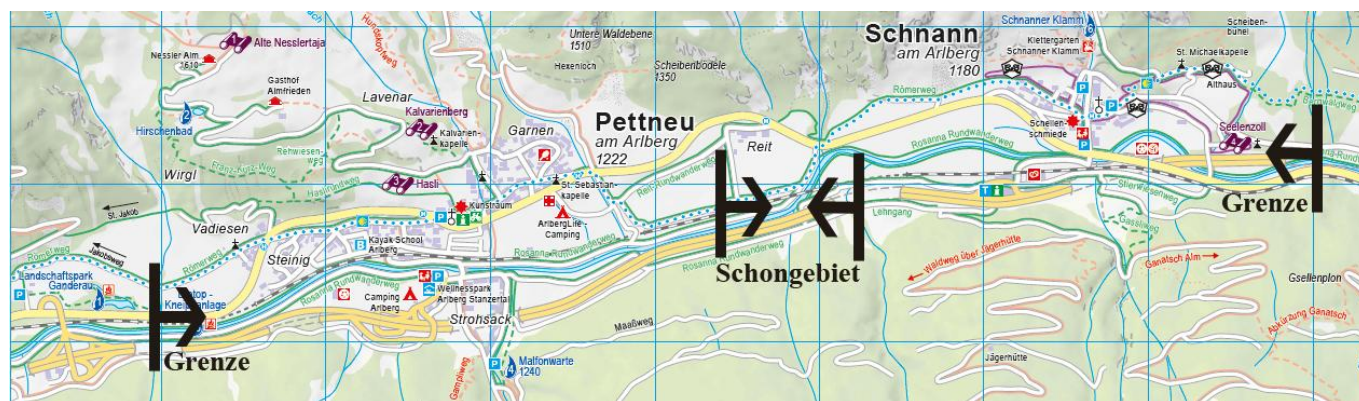


Fishing in Pettneu am Arlberg & Schnann

Fishing takes place in the Rosanna River, from the “Giasi-Bach” stream to the eastern fishing boundary of Schnann, including the Malfon Valley. Please note the protected area near the railway bridge, as indicated by the markings. The stream can be fished very well from both banks throughout the entire season.

This fishing area is also an Eldorado for fly-fishing enthusiasts, set amid a magnificent mountain backdrop. Spin fishing and live bait are prohibited!
